- **Start/Finish Line** Between the white flagpole at the Clubhouse and the nearer tangent of Mark S as boats approach on their normal course.
- **Courses** Courses will be set by the Race Officer from the Marks List on the attached map, and shall be displayed on the course board in the Clubhouse window.
- **Recalls** RRS29.2 shall not apply. Individual recalls will not be given. If a boat crosses the Starting Line prematurely an extra sound signal shall be made and the Class Warning Flag left at dip until all premature starters have returned to the proper side of the line, or until two minutes after the Starting Signal
- **Shortening Course** Flag S accompanied by two sound signals and the Class Flag if appropriate, indicates that the course shall be shortened to either (a) the number of laps completed by the leading boat when it next crosses the finishing line, or (b) a line between a mark and a boat displaying a blue flag.
- ProtestsProtests shall be heard by a committee of at least three members of OSC and shall
be heard as soon as mutually convenient following the incident.
Protests shall be made in accordance with RRS 61.
The time limit for lodging a protest shall be one hour after the last boat in the race
finishes. Protests shall be lodged with the Race Officer at the Race Office.
There shall be no protest fee.

The Prizegiving will be held at the Clubhouse as soon as possible after completion of racing on Sunday.
